The ACCA FIA accounting course allows you to start your pursuit in ACCA right after you have completed SPM or IGCSE O-Level. As a qualification on its own, it preps you for a supporting role in accounting in the workforce, equipping you with a strong foundation in financial and management accounting so that you can solve basic accounting problems.

Completing the ACCA FIA qualifications will allow you to progress to ACCA, which is a prestigious professional accounting qualification respected by many employers in the accounting industry. Students will earn multiple diplomas and certificates as they progress and complete the required examinations.

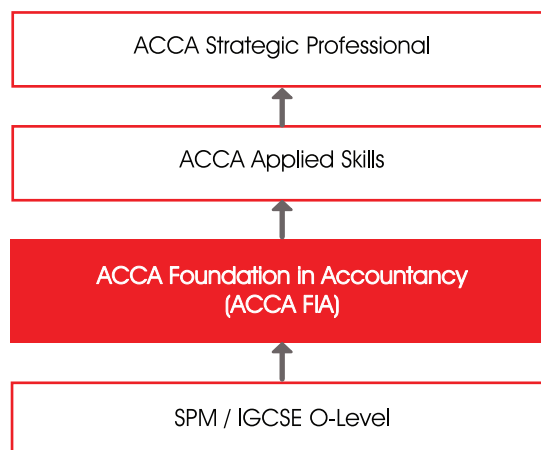
